

Instructions for registering & gaining access to IWMM / AKN portal:

- To register for access to IWMM / AKN portal, your project must be set up within the system and you must know the Project Code.
 - If you do not know if the project is set up, contact Linda Wires, IWMM Project Coordinator, linda_wires@fws.gov
 - Project Code can be obtained from Project Leader or IWMM Project Coordinator.
 - If you think the project you wish to join is already set up in the AKN (basically all IWMM projects initiated before 7/1/2015 or projects using the landbird or marshbird protocol):
 - Register by going to <http://data.pointblue.org/partners/iwmm/>
 - Enter your email address
 - If your email address isn't found, you will get a message indicating that user account was not found.

- Register by clicking on "[here](#)"
 - This will take you to registration page; fill out form and click "register" at the bottom of the page.
 - You will receive an e-mail saying your registration has been approved.
 - Once approved, you can login to IWMM portal at <http://data.pointblue.org/partners/iwmm/>
- If the project you wish to join is not yet setup, you will need to get the project set up before you register.

 - Once the project is set up and you have project code, follow process as above to register and gain access to IWMM portal.
