

Process for registering to gain access to IWMM / AKN portal:

- To register for access to IWMM / AKN portal, your project must be set up within the system and you must know the Project Code.
 - If you do not know if the project is set up, contact Linda Wires, IWMM Project Coordinator, linda_wires@fws.gov
 - Project Code can be obtained from Project Leader or IWMM Project Coordinator.
 - If you think the project you wish to join is already set up in the AKN (basically all IWMM projects initiated before 2015 or projects using the landbird or marshbird protocol):
 - Register by going to <http://www.pointblue.org/iwmm>
 - Enter your email address
 - If your email address isn't found, you will get a message indicating that user account was not found.
